




Parish changes

Children should only bring water to school in September, no juice is allowed.


#### Unauthorised absence

Unfortunately our unauthorised absence percentages have risen this year due to a high number of families taking holiday in term time. Whilst we fully appreciate holidays are much cheaper in term time, requests for leave can only be granted by schools if there are exceptional circumstances and holidays are not considered exceptional. They must also be made to the school in advance, as the Department for Education has told schools that we cannot authorise any absences after they have been taken.

The leave form has been updated and can be found on the website <a href="here">here</a> or via the school office.

We are the only school in Horsforth to not fine for holidays and our attendance officer has asked us to start to fine due to the increase in unauthorised holidays. The money does not come to our school. The fine is £60 per parent and £60 per child (for example a family of 4 with 2 parents and 2 children will be fined a total of £240).
