In English this half term, we will be studying a range of Anthony Browne books and looking closely at "Silly Billy" and "The Tunnel". Through these texts, we will be working towards writing stories, instructions, character descriptions and fact files. We will focus on different aspects of grammar and punctuation such as: expanded noun phrases, homophones, adding a range of suffixes and different types of sentences.

These spellings link to our weekly phonics, the Year Two spelling patterns as well as the common exception words we are focusing on.
