

Welcome back! I hope you all had a relaxing summer. I know from talking to the children that they have had a fun filled break catching up with family and friends which sounded lovely. I feel very lucky to be teaching this class again and look forward to making more memories together as we learn this year.

Year 4 are lucky to be supported in their learning this year by Mrs Quinn. Mrs Georghiou will teach on a Wednesday and Mrs Middleton on a Friday morning.

In English this half term, we will be studying the author Roald Dahl, where we will be looking at writing a biography. We will be looking at the book 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward, creating character and setting descriptions and linking this with our geography topic of recycling. This will lead to some cross curricular persuasive writing. The children will also look at writing non-chronological reports in science. We will have a specific grammar focus each week where we will look nouns and pronouns, conjunctions, and adverbials. We will also continue to practise the Year 3/4 spelling words, homophones and spelling rules.

In maths this half term, we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction. Every maths lesson will include fluency, reasoning and problemsolving elements and there will be plenty of opportunity to apply what we have learnt in real life scenarios. Every Monday, the maths lesson will be focused on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables. The children will have regular opportunities to practise their times tables each week.
