Dear Parents/Carers.

Welcome back to school. This half term our curriculum is packed full of knowledge and we will be busy!

It was lovely meeting you all during our virtual Parents Evening and I appreciate all the positive comments.

I hope that you will be able to attend our maths workshop. For those unable to attend a presentation a handout will be placed on the website. I recommend you read the information about the DFE Multiplication Test, which all children take in Year 4.

In English, our text focuses on migration as we follow the story of a little boy who travels across the world and his experiences of being an immigrant in the USA. Through this text, we will be working towards writing a play script, setting description and personal narrative. Our grammar focus when reading this text will be speech punctuation, expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials. In addition, we will have specific whole class reading sessions each week. We will also continue to work on spelling patterns and practise the Year 3/4 spelling words and homophones.

In maths this half term, we will be looking at addition, subtraction, perimeter, area, multiplication and division. We will also have a short session each week working on arithmetic skills and mental maths. We will have 3 sessions on times tables each week. Please encourage your child to use Times Table Rock Stars at home on a regular basis.
