
YEAR 4 AUTUMN 2 **CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER 2023**

Welcome back! We hope you all had a wonderful October holiday. It was lovely meeting you all during Parents' Evening and we appreciate the lovely comments made and the support. We have really enjoyed Autumn 1 with the children and are incredibly proud of how well they have settled into class.

We are delighted to welcome Miss Yasin to the Year 4 team. She will work in Year 4 full time, Monday to Friday. Miss Bartolotta will commence her maternity leave from Friday 17th November and we can't wait to meet the new addition when he arrives.

In English this half term, we will be studying a picture book called Flotsam, where we will be writing a narrative. We will also be producing some cross-curricular writing related to our history learning about the Shang Dynasty. We will have a specific grammar focus each week, predominately on the use of speech marks but we will continue to look at the use of nouns and pronouns, conjunctions, and adverbials. We will also continue to practise the Year 3/4 spelling words, homophones and spelling rules. Please encourage the children to use Spelling Shed, your feedback about it so far has been extremely positive.

In maths this half term, we will consolidate and extend our knowledge of addition and subtraction. Every maths lesson will include fluency, reasoning and problemsolving elements and there will be plenty of opportunity to apply what we have learnt in real life scenarios. Every Monday, the maths lesson will be focused on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables. The children will have regular opportunities to practise their times tables each week.
