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Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to school after the half term holiday.

I hope you and the children all enjoyed your time off and spent lots of time playing in autumn leaves and eating all the sweets that would have been for Halloween. This will be another busy half term with the continuation of our hard work and with the preparations for Christmas including the Year 6 assembly, Jesse Tree assemblies and Advent preparation.

This newsletter aims to inform you of the Year 6 curriculum for the forth coming half term and any important routines and dates.

Catch up sessions start this half term and will consist of a quick spellings session to start and then covering maths content that will cover any gaps and support the year 6 learning in class.

In English this half term, we will be studying Street Child by Berlie Doherty, looking at conservation/ animal rights and studying a Christmas advert. Through these texts and media we will be working towards writing descriptions, poetry and narratives. We will have a specific grammar focus each week where we will look at specific areas of year 6 grammar. We will also continue to practise the Year 5/6 spelling words and homophones.

In maths this half term we will be looking at: Fractions - comparing, ordering, using fractions with the four operations and problem solving; Geometry- position and direction, translations and reflections and Decimals: multiplication and division.

We will also have a short session each week working on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables up to 12 x 12.
